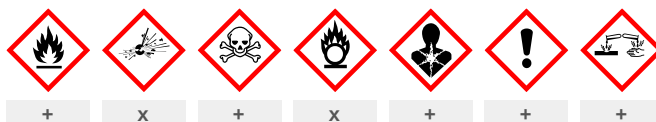

FIRST AID

Swallowed:	Do NOT give milk or oil. Do NOT give alcohol.
Eye:	Wash with running water (minimum 15 mins). Medical attention.
Skin:	Wash with soap & water. Apply cleansing cream.
Advice To Doctor:	Severe exposure indicated by respiratory distress/hypotension Managements is essentially supportive.
Fire Fighting:	Keep containers cool. Water spray/ fog.
Spills and Disposal:	Eliminate ignition sources. Absorb with dry agent. Stop leak if safe to do so. This material and its container must be disposed of in a safe way. To clean the floor and all objects contaminated by this material, use water.
